## Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)

### Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from HCC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- HCC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- HCC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
  - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
  - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications

### **Standard Agreement & P2P Agreement**

(Associate of Arts Multidisciplinary Studies to Bachelor of Science Interdisciplinary Studies)

### Program Admission Requirements

- Student must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- UHD accepts credit from coursework awarded “D” or above.

### Program Specific Requirements

- If students do not transfer with the suggested SPCH or PSYCH courses, they will need to take additional COMM or PSYCH courses at UHD in the electives areas to complete the minors.
- Earning a minor is not required. It is recommended though to assist students in their course selections.
